





JACK, SHARON AND KELLY OSBOURNE JOINED BY FAMOUS FRIENDS AT UN-MISS-ABLE DO

When Jack Osbourne was diagnosed with multiple sclerosis last year, his family were determined not to let the neurological condition stop them from turning their birthday into something special.

Now Jack and his mother Sharon have been honoured for their hard work, as the BBC announced that it will air a special show on Saturday night featuring the former *Big Brother* star, his wife Kelly and their two sons, plus a host of other celebrities.

Sharon also received the award presented by daughter Kelly, who has started her own charity supporting Jack.

Other performers appearing at the event included Sir Elton John, Leanne Lewis and Rick Springfield and his wife Penny.

A long-time friend of the Osbourne family, David Lee Roth

presented Sharon with a plaque on the backstage.

"We all support each other," Sharon said and "We're a weird family and we just do weird things."

"We're really happy to support Jack," added Roth. "It's the one thing missing in all of them and we just want everyone to have some fun and no worries for the day."

David Lee Roth joined the show's organiser, BBC programme *Strictly Come Dancing*, "It's amazing for me, I didn't know what sort of house-shape when Jack was diagnosed. We really worked together."

Looking forward, Sharon was uncompromising in her desire for her son Leo to be the one to give birth to their third child, daughter Pearl, next year. "The NHS has really taken a hand in our home," she said.

"It's great because it doesn't strain resources," Jack added. "She's starting to talk and just keeps up and trying to walk. There's a beautiful love in her and the future looks like a dream."

Jack and Penny have changed since his diagnosis, the 37-year-old said. "We're more seriously into giving about raising and about living life in that it seemed like I was the first young person to tell about it. But I'm not there are more others in

the world who have been affected. I can't wait until we're all better because there's a lot of lack of understanding about what this disease is."


"We really had to take a long hard look at our life to do this."

"When I'm not just a television star, I'm someone who can make a difference," he said of making people realise, "Let's prioritise things the way they need to be and think of work as a form of art."

"I was born into believe that we," he added. "I know it won't going to make Jack's life any easier. But a mother, I can understand how hard it is for Sharon to bear the news, but because Jack is doing amazingly well, it's not about it."

THE PAST YEAR HAS BEEN a whirlwind for Jack Osbourne, who has been juggling three major milestones at once: "It's crazy," he says of his life. "The wedding, the baby and the diagnosis. I had never heard of MS before I got my eyes checked last year. I was so shocked. I just thought it was something you hear about on TV, but it's actually something that's real."

"I didn't know anything about it, so I did some research online," he says. "I found out that my dad had it, so I figured it wasn't that bad. But then I saw all the different types of MS and realized it's not just one disease; there are many varieties, and some are really serious. That's why I study them. I have a doctor I work with who's been treating me. He's helped me learn more about the disease. And he's been a wonderful doctor."

"I appreciate things more now," he says. "I don't take anything for granted. I'm being more aware of what I have. I'm learning things and being grateful for things now."

What are you eating to stay healthy?

"I eat a lot of fruits and vegetables. I cook a lot of healthy meals."

How do you handle the diagnosis?

Osbourne says he's been doing a lot of research on the disease and its effects on the body. "I've learned that MS can affect different parts of the body differently, and it's important to understand those differences. It's also important to stay positive and not let the diagnosis get you down. It's important to remember that you're not alone. There are other people out there who are dealing with the same thing, and they can provide support and encouragement."

What are your favorite hobbies?

Osbourne loves to travel and explore new places. "I love to travel and see new things. I also enjoy spending time with my family and friends. I'm always looking for new adventures and experiences to have. I'm grateful for the opportunities I've had in my life, and I'm excited to see what the future holds."



Surveying the Rocky Mountain-punctuated horizon from atop the 40th floor of her home in 2009, Nancy Davis—founder of the annual Race to Erase MS gala, which celebrates its 20th anniversary this Saturday—raised her arms in exultation. “It’s so much fun,” she said. “I could really have passed for the ‘one’ character in an *Avatar* Spelling pastiche soap opera.”

Blonde, athletic, attractive with an ever-expansive personality and a curiously aloof, established grace established, the 58-year-old had two young boys, a blossoming career (she has *Blair Davis*, co-executive of magazine *Esquire*’s party-planning division at 20th Century Fox) and The Beverly Hills Hotel, as well as the time and to have inspired Spelling’s *90210* phenomenon *Dynasty*, and a mother, Barbara, who was and continues to be a cornerstone on the social and entertainment scenes, and the matriarch who would call a philanthropic enterprise “My daughter’s name had just left the Inter, and to the first Channel 4 bid [joined by Barbara Davis in 1979]. She started doing movies,” says Nancy, who has four siblings and was born and raised in Denver but moved to Los Angeles in 1987.

Of course, as in any soap opera, there were problems, namely a not-so-happy marriage. The mother was too afraid to end the general miasma of the mid-80s as she started her climbout into the sky above Aspen.

in addition to her injured knee, followed by a second doctor, and a neurologist whom Davis has pinned to those fingers on her right hand, a condition that soon spread down her body. “Everything dramatically changed in a very short period,” she says. “You can't believe you're sitting in a doctor's office and somebody is pointing at black spots on your X-rays and saying they are lesions in your brain and spinal cord.”

The prognosis was beyond dismal. There were no drugs, no remedies, no hope or option except a last-ditch decision: “At least you don't have a long time,” says Davis, who remembers leaving the office, getting into the elevator, and being overwhelmed by fear of the unknown.

But Davis “was good at staying in bed,” she says. “I never asked such a nice doctor for added pills,” and she has “never been good at taking no for an answer.” Determined to remain positive, she took action. “I had three kids, I didn't have time to lie down to a negative prognosis.” Second opinions were sought, alternative and holistic options. Davis used corporately funded cash to establish one research center to monitor and track physical anomalies to understand that, yes, she did effectively have MS. More important for the purpose of MS treatment, she discovered that much of the research being

conducted at these centers was duplicate. "These truly brilliant doctors all thought they were the only ones doing a particular study; none knew they were repeating each other's work," says Davis, who in 2006 documented her journey with the book *Lessons My Ten Powerful Steps to Moving Beyond Your Diagnosis and Taking Back Your Life*.

From that eureka moment, Davis's mission broadened from maintaining her own life and

health to masterminding an unprecedented approach to attacking a disease via charity. A little more than a year after her diagnosis, she launched the Nancy Davis Foundation for Multiple Sclerosis. Its primary focus, to facilitate the most cutting-edge and aggressive research into understanding the causes of MS and developing new treatments; its primary means, the Center Without Walls program; its mission, to create and coordinate a network of multidisciplinary scientific programs and experts across the country.

To fund her vision, Davis returned to the family staple: creative philanthropy. In 1993, the same year she established her foundation, she started the Race to Erase MS. What began as a ski weekend in Aspen, raising \$1.3 million that inaugural year, has grown into the star-spangled spectacle it is today. "I never want the gala to be that invitation that gets the 'Oh, do I have to go?' response," says Davis, who keeps the agenda—cocktail, live performances, a celebrity fashion show, live and silent auctions, and dinner—fresh through her enormous contact list and the generosity of the celebrities and entertainers therein, who appear gratis (past performers have included Gwen Stefani, Avril Lavigne, Sheryl Crow, Stevie Wonder, and such film and television personalities as David Arquette and Dennis Hopper).

"MS wasn't in my job description," says Davis, who interned at the US Supreme Court during college out of the desire to be a criminal attorney. "But the greatest benefit of having MS has been that it's now become my career." As far as how successful that career has been thus far: Of the nine drugs addressing MS currently approved by the FDA, Race to Erase MS was involved in seven. And her own battle with MS? "I'm an even more lucious skier," Davis says, adding that she continues to play tennis and, post-diagnosis, started learning karate. She is now a black belt.

The 10th annual *Race to Erase MS: Less to Erase MS* takes place May 3 at the Hyatt Regency Century Plaza, 2025 Avenue of the Stars, LA, entrancing LAC.





John also teased his long-time friend Rod Stewart, and got sentimental when he explained that one of the highlights of the night was going to sit with him. "We go back a long way," John said from the stage in his fellow British icon. "I love you, man."

Following John's performance, Stewart told *Rolling Stone* the affection was mutual. "I've just been enjoying the performance of my mate," he said. Through pure adoration praise for John's opening album *The Diving Board*, due in September ("It's so good!"), he promised.

John dazzled in his solo performance. He ran through several mega-hits, from a boogie woogie "Philadelphia Freedom" to an extended "Bennie Man." In recent years, John has been focused on his Las Vegas residencies and hasn't toured much. Last night Ziggy Marley and country star Kellie Pickler got their first-ever opportunity to witness him live. Pickler had a suggestion for the singer: "I think he needs to come to the CMAs one year. That would be amazing," she said. It's not so far-fetched, as there are a lot of rock acts who go to the Country Music Awards, and John has been very open to working with young artists in the past. If Pickler gets her wish and she gets to perform with him, what would she want to do?

"It would be fun to sing a classic country song — maybe pull out an old Tammy [Wynn] and George [Jones]," she said. "He can do anything he wants to do. He's Elton John."

For Marley, the chance to see John and support the cause made for an easy choice to come out. "That's the good thing about having someone like him play events like this; he brings us all to support," Marley said.

Marley, like Grammys presenter Eric "Buckshot" Thal, was on hand because of personal connections to the illness. "We have a friend who suffers from MS and she invited us how to best support the cause," Marley said. Thal explained, "One of my best friends was married with the disease about 15 years ago and we started a non-profit organization, a group in New Jersey, the MS Research Foundation. I am here to give my positive vibe, no support, anything I can do to help spread awareness."

Thal summed up the aim of all those in attendance last night when he said "We all have the same goal here; we want to do something to maintain the quality of life (for those) that have this disease."

Jack Osbourne was diagnosed last year and admitted he was initially reluctant to accept the recognition. "It was bittersweet. I was like, 'Can't you honor me for not having MS? I'd rather that.' Of course, I have to accept it. This is a fight far bigger than myself, far bigger than anyone in this room," said the 27-year-old.

In true Osbourne fashion, he lightened the mood. "This is like the bar mitzvah I never had... and I have my own ping pong now," he laughed, while holding the goblet-shaped award.

Davis' foundation and its Center Without Walls program attracted longtime supporters Anne Heche and James Tupper, Tommy Hilfiger, Harry Hamlin and Lisa Rinna, Kristin Cavallari, sisters Aly and AJ Michalka, Daisy Fuentes, Ray Romano, Rod Stewart, Kathy Hilton and Kelly Osbourne, and newbies Neil Patrick Harris, Cat Deeley, Kellie Pickler, Melanie Sykes and Bella Thorne.

I remember that song so well from school because Kathy Hilton and I used to sing it in class all the time. Mike [as in her brother Michael] used to say, 'Kathy, will you be quiet? You're going to get us in trouble.'

"He is the bravest boy, man, father, person I know," said Kelly as she welcomed her brother to the stage to collect his Medal of Hope at The Race 2 Erase MS fundraiser in Los Angeles.

"I feel like this is the bar mitzvah I never had," joked Jack as he collected the accolade in the Hyatt Century Plaza's grand ballroom.

Jack's shock diagnosis, revealed exclusively to HELLO!, came a mere two weeks after he and wife Lisa welcomed their daughter Pearl, who is now one.

After experiencing a frightening episode, during which he lost most of the vision in his right eye, Jack was diagnosed the incurable autoimmune disease that attacks the brain and central nervous system.

Since then Jack, 27, has helped raise the profile of the condition and now says 'adapt and overcome' is his life motto.

"I think there's a reason why people get certain things in life," said Sharon, who has spoken at length about her son's condition on her chat show *The Talk*: "And why you're given certain hurdles to get over," she added.

"I think it's made my son realise how blessed he is," Sharon continued. "He has amazing friends, he has an amazing family and it makes you appreciate what you've got in life."

Jack's dad **Ozzy Osbourne** did not attend the fundraiser and auction, but Elton John and David Furnish did, as did fellow friends of the Osbournes, Rod Stewart and Penny Lancaster.



Sharon Osbourne, 60, was a judge on "America's Got Talent" from 2007 to 2012. Several British tabloids (including The Sun and The Daily Mirror) have been reporting for months that Sharon Osbourne is going to replace Tulisa Contostavlos as a judge on "The X Factor" U.K.

Representatives for "The X Factor" U.K. aren't commenting yet on these reports, but the official announcement should be made sometime in May 2013.

In 2012, the four "X Factor" U.K. judges were Contostavlos, Gary Barlow, Nicole Scherzinger and Louis Walsh.

Sharon Osbourne and her youngest child, Jack Osbourne, received awards at the 20th Annual Race to Erase MS "Love to Erase MS" gala, in recognition of their charity and awareness work to fight [multiple sclerosis](#). The star-studded event was held at the Hyatt Regency Century Plaza in Los Angeles on May 3, 2013.

Jack Osbourne, 27, was diagnosed with multiple sclerosis in 2012. That same year, [Sharon Osbourne](#) quit NBC's "[America's Got Talent](#)" because she said that after Jack went public with having multiple sclerosis, NBC reneged on a verbal agreement to cast Jack in the reality show "Stars Earn Stripes." Sharon claimed that NBC discriminated against Jack because the network did not want to deal with insurance issues that would be required for Jack to be on the show. NBC denied the accusation and said that there was never an agreement for Jack to be on "Stars Earn Stripes."

It hasn't been officially announced yet who the four judges will be on NBC's "[The X Factor](#)" (10 p.m., May 18), but "[The X Factor](#)" executive producer Simon Cowell and co-hosts in an April 2013 interview with [Entertainment Weekly](#) [Cowell](#) [declined](#) to say who the judges will be in replacement of the departing ones.

Sharon Osbourne is also expected to announce in May 2013 that she is quitting the upcoming CBS chat show "[The Talk](#)" (renewed; it's based in Los Angeles), in order to host "[The X Factor](#)" U.K., which is based in London. Sharon Osbourne has been one of the original co-hosts of "[The Talk](#)" since its 2010 debut. She was a judge on "[The X Factor](#)" (U.K.), from 2004 to 2007.

NBC's "[The Factor](#)" (airing in 2013) is reportedly going to be \$2 million per \$2 million in U.S. ratings, which would make it the highest-rated series on the small screen in 2013. Cowell, who was a judge on the show from 2004 to 2012, is the only one to have had a higher "[X Factor](#)" rating since he is an executive producer-co-creator of the show.

Meanwhile, at the 20th Annual Race to Erase MS "Love to Erase MS" gala (which is hosted by Harry Connick Jr.), Sharon Osbourne was seen mingling with several stars, including Ellen DeGeneres (who performed at the event), Seal, Steven Tyler, Maksim Chmerkovskiy (also known as Maks), who replaced Sharon Osbourne on "[America's Got Talent](#)", and Patrick Swayze and Timothy Omundson.

Sharon's daughter Kelly Osbourne, 28, was also at the event, as well as Jack Osbourne's wife, Lisa Stelly. Timo Cruz performed at the gala.

Sharon's husband, Ozzy Osbourne, was not at the event because he was in Australia while on Black Sabbath's world tour. The couple's marital problems have been in the news after several media outlets reported in April 2013 that Sharon and Ozzy are living apart and haven't been sharing their wedding rings.

The news, however, prompted Ozzy (who is a recovering alcoholic, and thus won't do confrontations), to say that he had a relapse from late 2012 to early 2013, but he insisted that he and Sharon are [last time I checked](#). He also made a public apology for how he behaved during his relapse. Sharon, though, performed on "[The Talk](#)" that she and Ozzy aren't [alright](#), but she admitted that she is "devastated" for Ozzy's relapse, which she said was one of the main causes of their marital difficulties.

Ozzy, Sharon, Jack and Kelly have all spent time in rehab for addiction issues, at various points in their lives. They all starred in the Emmy-winning MTV reality show "[The Osbournes](#)" from 2002 to 2005. Sharon and Ozzy's oldest child, Aimee, was not a part of the show, and she has chosen to stay out of the celebrity spotlight.

Stones, What Stones? Elton Owns Beverly Hills Crowd

Sir Elton gives donors at dinner scrooge event more than their money's worth. Plus: Rose McGowan is the main in the middle of Jay Leno and Chelsea Handler; Ben Stiller banks on Matt Damon; and the "Star Trek" crew England.



By Mike Wasserman At the same time that the Rolling Stones had the Lakers Plus Casal and 10,000 others enjoying Staples Center in May for a reason other than the NBA playoffs on Friday night, Sir Elton John was making his own statement in Century City. He can hold a room of really rich philanthropists and rock stars right by himself — just add a piano.

"Good evening ladies and gentlemen, I'm Paul Sherriff," Sir Elton quipped, acknowledging his "great mate" sitting at the head table in head-to-toe white.

Filling the seat of his Yamaha that had haunted the stage on the grand ballroom of the Century Plaza for a few hours, Sir Elton shared the back story on how he arrived at the 20th Annual Race to Erase MS Gala. "The only reason I'm doing this is because Sharon Osbourne has so much info on me," he said. "I shouldn't say no."

Sharon and son Jack, who was diagnosed with multiple sclerosis last June at age 26, anchored the annual pinnacle of Nancy Davis' campaign for MS research. As the honorees and unofficial co-chairs, Osbourne fingerprints were all over the night.



"This is like the Bar Mitzvah I never had," Jack said after an introduction by his sister, Kelly (above left). He called his glass a "Pimm's Cup," referencing the traditional British summer cocktail.

"You always wanted a medal on a ribbon," Sharon added. "Who would have thought it would come from M.S.? I thought it would come from the queen."

Only one of the public Osbournes was missing: "Dad's on tour with Black Sabbath," Kelly said, a unique revelation.

Far from the Sabbath, but in the same ballroom that hosts Yom Kippur services, Sir Elton gave a non-denominational effort, summing up his love of life or death about him over 20 pieces of his own AIDS Foundation gales both here on Oscar night and in England during the summer. He had everyone from Ginnifer Goodwin to Matt Damon to Cyndi Lauper's full attention at stage right.

His eight-song greatest hits set opened with "Tiny Dancer," and continued with "Your Song," followed that with "They Call It the Blues," "Rock Me," "Philadelphia Freedom," "Don't Let the Sun Go Down on Me," "I'm Still Standing," and concluded with a "Love King" medley, "Circle of Life" and "Can You Feel the Love Tonight?"



He closed with three commanding catastrophes of the industry: dinner with really drivers (Liam Neeson, Lisa Rinna, a handful of others); Hugh Hefner's day of Beverly Hills'; British rock older sisters (Stewart, always with wife Penny), rock solid working actors (Paul Patrick Harris, Catherine Bell), legal celebrities (Chris Noth, Robert Wagner), a pile of Davis' aces, (including a gift bag the size of the John FTR family's beach bag), and one rainy Tomell cutting lines and squeezing through screens.

Elton ended this 47-minute set by jumping right off the stage into the pit of leather to hug his mom, and then greeting nearly every person that stood between him and the exit at stage right.

As to Crystal Method's Tommy Hilfiger, a regular since it was an actual "band" in Aspen in the early days, had already wisely made use of Elton's downed motto earlier to beat the hordeous Century Plaza hotel. Smart man.

The 27-year-old reality star was diagnosed with multiple sclerosis last year and he and mum Sharon were given Medals of Hope at the Race to Erase MS event in Los Angeles.

The matriarch walked the red carpet with daughter and Fashion Police star Kelly, while Jack was joined by his wife Lisa Stelly. Dad Ozzy Osbourne - who recently admitted to a drink and drugs relapse - was notably absent from the event.

But the rest of the family were in good company as they were joined by singer Rod Stewart and his wife Penny Lancaster, Spice Girl Melanie Brown, reality star LaToya Jackson and Revenge star Berry Sloane.

Elton John and Taio Cruz both performed at the star-studded bash.

Speaking on the red carpet, Sharon said: "We feel totally spoilt by our friends and family and everybody has been amazing with us. At times like this you realise how lucky you are to be surrounded by so many friends."

Jack revealed how difficult it is to battle the misconceptions about his illness. He said: "When I came out about it in an interview in a magazine the front said 'I will not let my son die'.

"But one per cent of people diagnosed with MS die from symptoms of MS so I thought 'That's right, I'm not going to die because I wasn't going to anyway'.

"Stuff like that has to change on a global level, people have to understand you can live with this and have a high quality of life, people have to wake up to understand what it really is."

Jack said his mum was far more deserving of the gong than himself: "If anyone is deserving it's her because she's been more out front about this than anyone. She's been so supportive - it's nice that it's a family affair."


